TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. RENTAL

- 1.1 The renter agrees to pay the EFCL the rental fees in the form of cash or a cheque that is dated in accordance with the *first day* of the rental agreement. The damage deposit must be paid by a separate cheque dated in accordance with the *last day* of the rental agreement.
- 1.2 The renter understands that the EFCL will not prorate rental fees or damage deposits for rentals shorter than 30 days.
- 1.3 If the equipment is not returned within 2 business days of the rental period expiration date, the EFCL will cash the damage deposit cheque to cover the full replacement cost of the equipment.

2. EQUIPMENT CARE AND CONDITION

- 2.1 The renter and an EFCL staff member will conduct an inspection of the equipment prior to *commencement* of the rental and identify any damage or other conditions present. The renter and an EFCL staff member will conduct a second inspection *following* the return of the equipment to identify any damage arising from the renter's use.
- 2.2 If the equipment is considered to be in good condition following the second inspection, the EFCL will immediately return the damage deposit cheque to the renter.
- 2.3 The EFCL will cash the damage deposit cheque to cover the full replacement cost for each piece of equipment returned damaged or missing. Any funds remaining will be returned to the renter by cheque.

3. LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

- 3.1 The renter agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the EFCL, Community Leagues, and Urban Poling Inc. from any and all liability, loss, or other damage claims to persons or property resulting from use of the urban poling equipment, including any such claims which allege negligent acts.

4. INSURANCE

- 4.1 The renter has adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage that may be caused or suffered while using the urban poling equipment or agrees to bear the costs of such injury or damage to oneself.
