## Municipal Guidelines - City of Edmonton

The City of Edmonton's Public Places Bylaw regulates where smoking is permitted in public places: this includes tobacco, vaping and cannabis. Cannabis Smoking and Vaping Rules in Edmonton<sup>2</sup>:

Location	Permitted Use	Prohibited Use
Home	Within home and yard.	Where property owners, landlords, condo boards and rental companies restrict smoking and growing of cannabis on their properties and in common areas.
Public Spaces, Parkland and Commercial Buildings	In some parks and on some trails.	<ul> <li>Where the park contains:</li> <li>A playground, sports field, skate or bicycle park, outdoor theatre, outdoor pool or water spray park, seasonal skating rink or off leash area.</li> </ul>
		<ul> <li>On or within any:</li> <li>Hospital property, school property, child care facility property, city-owned golf course, cemetery, ski hill, bus terminal or light rail transit platform.</li> </ul>
		Or in the following locations: Sir Winston Churchill Square, Fort Edmonton Park, The John Janzen Nature Centre, The Edmonton Valley Zoo, The Muttart Conservatory or William Hawrelak Park
Sidewalks	On some sidewalks.	Within 10 metres from a bus stop or the doorway, window or air intake of a building or patio.
Vehicles	In a vehicle being used as a temporary residence,	Cannabis cannot be consumed in a vehicle. This includes public vehicles like buses, taxis and LRT.
