Flag Football- Fall 2022

Thank you for your interest to see flag football at your League this fall.

The EFCL is working with the [Capital District Minor Football Association](#) (CDMFA) to create a community opportunity for kids to play closer to home.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Will this generate revenue for Leagues that host, or just be a no-cost use of League facilities?

A. The CDMFA will pay the League for use of their facilities.

Q. What damage will the rink facilities sustain?

A. We don't foresee any damages, due to the age of the children and the nature of the sport.

Q. Is access to indoor spaces and change rooms or washrooms necessary?

A. It's not required but access to washrooms is always beneficial.

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Q. If there is damage, will there be a rental agreement that covers it through insurance?

A. See below link to CDMFA insurance; this also covers all players and is part of fees. A rental agreement will be created for all Leagues that enter into this arrangement with CDMFA.

Q. What age groups would this be for?

A. This would be for the following age groups:

- U7: birth years 2016-2018
- U10: birth years 2013-2015
- U13: birth years 2010-2012
 - U13 is tentative. It will be determined closer to the fall if this is feasible once we have the registration numbers.

Q. What will the League have to do?

A. Each League requires a main contact, who will receive email confirmation of each registration confirmed on your League team. No further work is required by the League.

Q. What about refunds for families if their child can no longer play? Who is responsible for this?

A. The CDMFA has a policy for refunds to players. Anyone who needs this should [contact CDMFA directly through their website](#).

Q. What about waivers and forms?

A. Waivers and registration forms will be managed by CDMFA. Direct any questions about this back to CDMFA.



Q. What days of the week will the games be?

A. Games and practices will be on weekends due to sunset times in the fall. Weekend games will also assist CDMFA in hiring coaches.

Q. What does this restrict us from doing?

A. If the rink is going to be used for football, it can't be used as an off-leash park for pets.

Q. What are the fees to play?

- A. The fees are \$225 per child for eight weeks of play. This includes the following:
- One paid coach per team that has been screened and hired by CDMFA or the [Greater Edmonton Flag Football Association](#) (GEFFA)
 - One lead supervisor per location that has been screened and hired by CDMFA/GEFFA
 - NFL FLAG reversible performance jerseys
 - NFL FLAG core shorts
 - NFL FLAG x NERF x SUBWAY flag belts
 - NFL FLAG x NERF footballs
 - Football Alberta insurance and membership
 - Football Canada membership
 - Eight games that are each 60-minutes long

CDMFA will have a Kidsport/Jumpstart payment option for families. If the League is interested in covering the costs for kids in the neighbourhood, you can receive a promo code to provide to the family. CDMFA will then invoice the League accordingly. Leagues can determine the amount that will be covered by the promo code (up to 100 per cent of fees).

The League is responsible for cutting the grass inside the rink. CDMFA will look after any other set up required.
